

There is now a professional standard for pest management

The Standard - BS EN 16636:2015

Developed as a group initiative by industry representatives alongside the Confederation of European Pest Control Associations (CEPA), the first British quality standard for pest management services was released in 2015. BS EN 16636:2015 specifies the requirements for the provision of the professional, effective and economical reduction of damage caused by pests with an aim to protect public health, property and the environment.

Prior to the introduction of the standard, the pest control industry lacked licensing requirements and common international standards which proved difficult when selecting a reputable contractor and since its release, the initiative has further developed to set a clear benchmark for pest management.



What Qualifies as a CEPA Certified® Pest Control Company?


